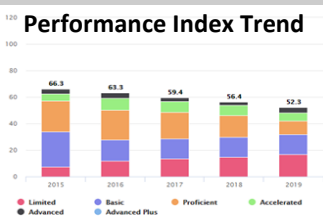

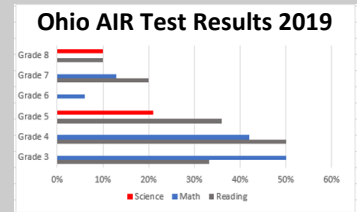

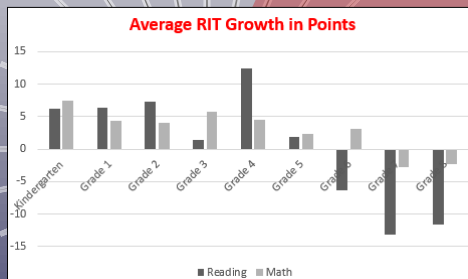

About our Sponsor:
